The Committee reviews data as to comparable compensation for similarly qualified persons in functionally comparable positions at similarly situated organizations. The Committee is also tasked with carrying out contemporaneous documentation and recordkeeping with respect to the deliberations and decisions regarding the compensation arrangement.
