He has been a member of ABC since 2005, previously serving on the Plumbing Apprentice Committee, the Carpentry Committee and board member. Zamora started AnchorBuilt in 1996 after he developed a passion in construction while working with his grandfather, a stone mason. A carpenter and plumber, Zamora now runs the company he started with his wife, which employs more than 50 people.

Zamora is also a member of the National Association of Industrial and Office Properties, U.S. Green Building Council and American Institute of Architects. He is also president of Humble Fish, a nonprofit organization Zamora started with his family to assist families with food during the holiday season. Since 2009, Humble Fish has provided thousands of food baskets to families in Albuquerque and the surrounding areas.
