110th Congress

ROLL CALL 227 H.R. 800 Employee Free Choice Act

ABC's stance Oppose

Passage of the Employee Free Choice Act would effectively rob American workers of their right to a private ballot election overseen by the National Labor Relations Board when deciding whether to join a union. It would replace the secret ballot with a scheme called "card check," whereby workers are forced to vote in public--inviting coercion, intimidation and abuse into the workplace.

ROLL CALL 228 S. 1639 Immigration Reform

ABC's stance Support

For almost a decade, comprehensive reform of U.S. immigration laws has been a top priority for the construction industry. As Congress has struggled with the proper way to move forward on this controversial issue, construction employers have been at the forefront calling for reforms to the U.S. immigration system.

S. 3268 Stop Excessive Energy Speculation Act

ABC's stance Oppose

ABC believes this Bill has no apparent plan to allow consideration of any other legislative proposals that would decrease America's dependence on foreign energy. Responsible oil and gas development must be allowed in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge. Deepwater offshore drilling must be brought online, oil shale technology must be developed, and new refineries must be built. These important issues are not addressed in the energy speculation bill.

ABC's stance Oppose

The Lilly Ledbetter Fair Pay Act is an extreme piece of legislation that would effectively eliminate the statute of limitations from employment discrimination claims. The consequences would mean countless claims being filed based on alleged acts that could have occurred decades ago, well after memories have faded, documents and witnesses have disappeared, and businesses have changed hands or no longer exist.

ABC Stance: Supports, but Opposes tabling the Amendment

ABC is in strong support of the DeMint Amendment, S. Amdt.2844 which waives Davis-Bacon Act requirements on certain projects in H.R. 3074. The Davis-Bacon Act discourages many qualified small and minority-owned contractors from bidding on public projects because of the complex and inefficient wage and work restrictions. As a result, few small and minority-owned firms win Davis-Bacon contracts, and many others give up trying. Davis-Bacon also prices out entry-level workers.
