On July 6, 2009, you were advised that the Department of Labor (DOL) would be conducting a Davis-Bacon wage survey of residential weatherization construction on projects active from April 1, 2008 to March 31, 2009 for the States of California, Connecticut, Illinois, Iowa, Maine, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Missouri, Michigan, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin with a survey start date of July 6, 2009 and a survey cut-off date of July 15, 2009.

The Department has heard from multiple interested parties expressing concern that there was no advance notice of this survey and also concern over whether they would be able to submit relevant information within the timeframe allotted. Although this survey is limited in scope to just weatherization construction work on residential projects in the states listed above—and there is a need to expedite the survey to ensure that workers on such projects are paid at least the locally prevailing wage rates and fringe benefits—the Department wants to ensure that it receives as complete and as accurate data as possible. In light of the concerns raised, the Department has therefore decided to extend the survey cut-off date to July 31, 2009.
