Dear Sir or Madam:

This is to advise you of a Davis-Bacon wage survey of residential weatherization construction for the States of **California, Connecticut, Illinois, Iowa, Maine, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Missouri, Michigan, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin**. The Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (DBRA) require payment of locally prevailing wage rates and fringe benefits to employees of contractors and subcontractors performing work on federally financed or assisted construction projects. The Wage and Hour Division of the U.S. Department of Labor is responsible for conducting prevailing wage surveys to establish the wage rates to be included in wage determinations applicable to such construction projects.

This office will be soliciting information on wages and fringe benefits paid to workers working on weatherization projects that were under construction or completed during the period from **April 1, 2008** through **March 31, 2009**.

Data must be submitted by July 15, 2009 to be included in the survey.

A survey spreadsheet, a completed sample spreadsheet, and a definitions and instructions sheet are enclosed for your use. The survey spreadsheet may also be completed and submitted electronically.
