ABC members won in all three categories in the CURT CISE Constructor Safety Awards. Contractors recognized for their outstanding safety performance over the past three years were:

NAICS Code 236: General Building Contractors

NAICS Code 237: Heavy Construction Contractors

- **Teton Industrial Construction, Inc.** – (more than 2 million man hours per year). Operating out of Alpharetta, Ga., and Port Neches, Texas, Teton Industrial Construction, Inc., is a member of ABC’s Georgia and Southeast Texas chapters.
- **S&B Engineers and Constructors, Ltd.** – (more than 2 million man hours per year). This Houston-based contractor is a member of ABC’s Greater Houston chapter.

NAICS Code 238: Special Trade Contractors

- **IES Industrial Inc.** – (500,000 to 2 million man hours per year). Based in Holdrege, Neb., IES Industrial Inc., is a member of 16 ABC chapters across the country.

- **Canyon Concrete, Inc. (Honorable Mention)** – (500,000 or less man hours per year). Headquartered in Farmington, Mo., Canyon Concrete, Inc. is a member of ABC’s Heart of America chapter.
