WASHINGTON, D.C. – Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) announced that Jerry Gorski, president of Gorski Engineering, Inc., Collegetown, Pa., and a member of ABC’s Southeast Pennsylvania and Eastern Pennsylvania chapters, has assumed the duties of 2009 ABC national chairman. Gorski spent two years as chairman of the Member Services Coordinating Committee and served as chairman of the board of directors of the for-profit ABC Services Corp.

At the chapter level, Gorski was chairman of the Southeastern Pennsylvania Chapter in 1996 and has more than 10 years of service on the chapter’s board of directors. He also has served as chairman of chapter committees on membership, nominations and member involvement.

Gorski is a 1982 Presidential Scholar graduate of Clarkson University (Potsdam, N.Y.) where he was inducted into two engineering honor societies.
