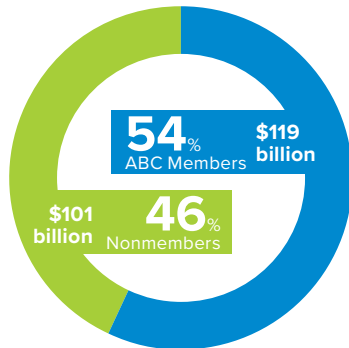
ABC HELPS ITS MEMBERS WIN WORK

ABC Members Win Work Through Fair and Open Competition



Federal Contracts

Fiscal years 2009-2024

In fiscal year 2024, ABC members won \$7.8 billion in federal contracts of \$35 million or more—52% of the total value. During fiscal years 2009-2024, ABC members won 54% of the value of federal contracts of \$35 million or more, totaling \$119 billion.



Government-mandated PLAs steer work to unionized contractors and their unionized workforces, which represent just 10.3% of the U.S. private construction workforce, according to the latest U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics data. Therefore, PLA requirements deny opportunity to nearly 9 out of 10 U.S. private construction workers.

ABC Opposes Government-Mandated PLAs

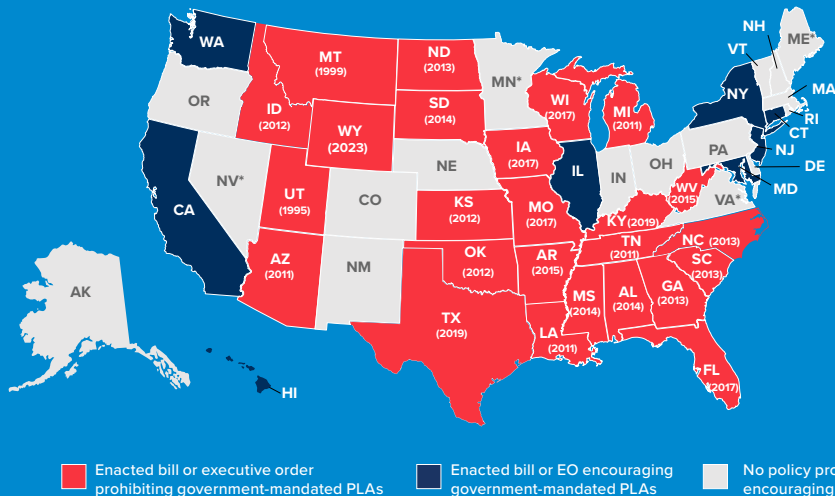
Anti-competitive and costly government-mandated PLAs end open, fair and competitive bidding on contracts to build taxpayer-funded construction projects.

Government-mandated PLAs discourage merit shop contractors from bidding on taxpayer-funded construction contracts and drive up costs by 12% to 20%.

An ABC-led coalition created the website **BuildAmericaLocal.com** as part of a campaign to explain the value of fair and open competition on federal and federally assisted construction projects.

State laws have prevented government-mandated project labor agreements on more than \$1.35 trillion worth of state and local government construction work since 2007.

ABC Is a Leader in Advocacy

Thanks to the generous support of ABC members, ABC PAC broke records in the 2023-2024 election cycle, contributing over \$2.4 million to federal candidates who believe in free enterprise, and sending merit shop champions to Congress and the White House. ABC PAC contributed to 210 winning races, with a win rate of 85%, and conducted seven independent expenditure ad campaigns in key districts.

During the 2023-2024 election cycle, ABC's Free Enterprise Alliance raised nearly \$6 million and invested over \$5 million in issue advocacy and, separately, get-out-the-vote campaigns promoting the values of the merit shop construction industry. FEA launched issue ad campaigns in 24 states, generating over 100 million impressions among key voters. Thanks to FEA, ABC is a powerhouse when it comes to educating members, the public and elected officials about the importance of fair and open competition in construction.

ABC Supports Full Repeal of the Davis-Bacon Act

In the absence of full repeal of the Davis-Bacon Act, ABC is fighting for commonsense reforms that will deliver more value to taxpayers. The U.S. Department of Labor's August 2023 final rule updating Davis-Bacon Act regulations disregarded the feedback of ABC and contractors opposing the rule's reversal of prior reforms and distortion of the prevailing wage process. In November 2023, ABC filed an ongoing lawsuit in federal court challenging the costly and burdensome rule.

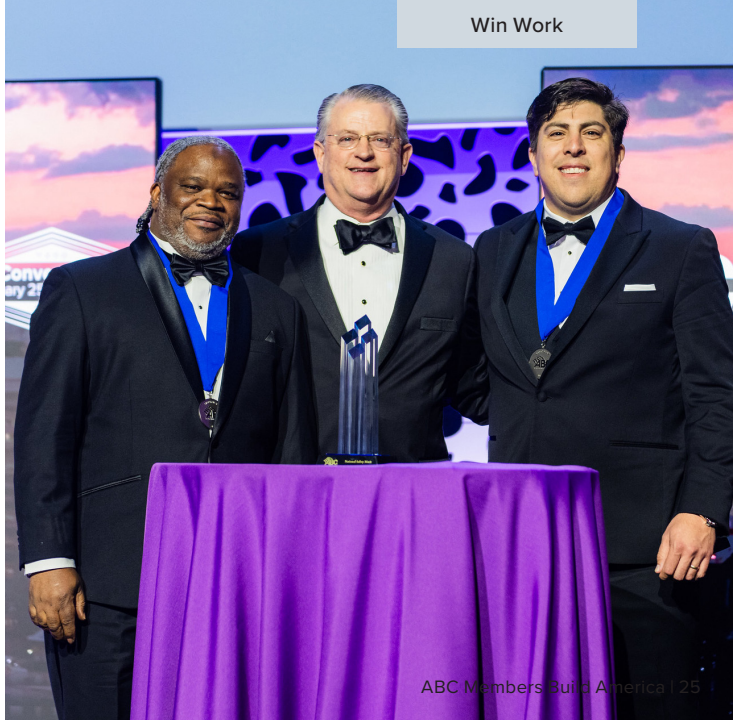

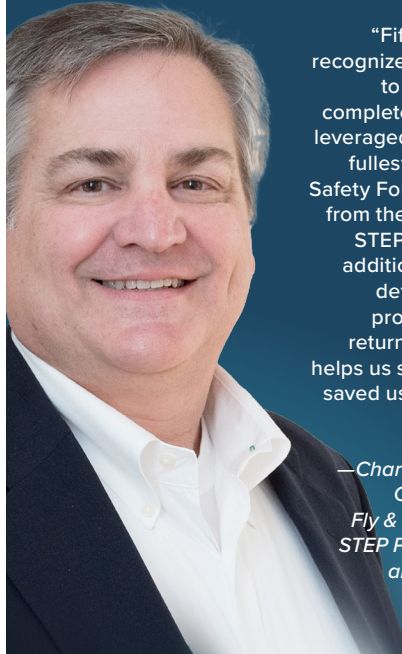

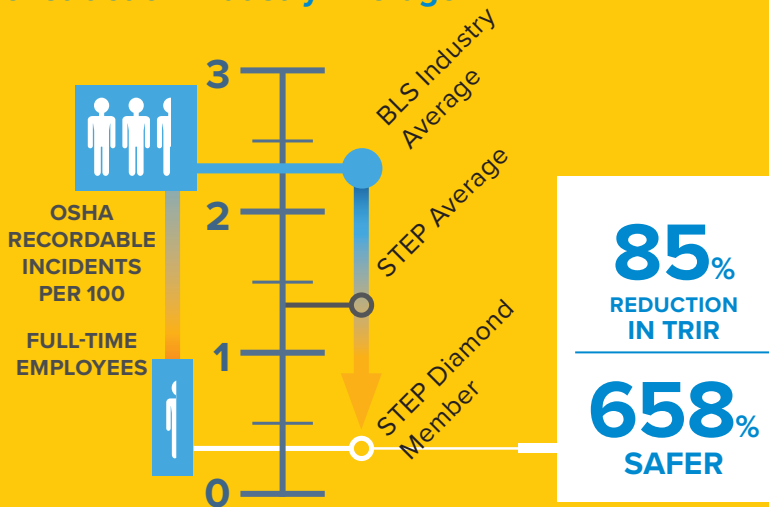
STEP Diamond Members Are Nearly 7 Times Safer Than the Industry Average

The best-performing participants in ABC's STEP® Health and Safety Management System lowered their total recordable incident rate by 85% compared to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics construction industry average, according to data gathered from ABC members recording more than 1 billion hours of work in construction, heavy construction, civil engineering and specialty trades.

Total Recordable Incident Rates: STEP vs. the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics Industry Average

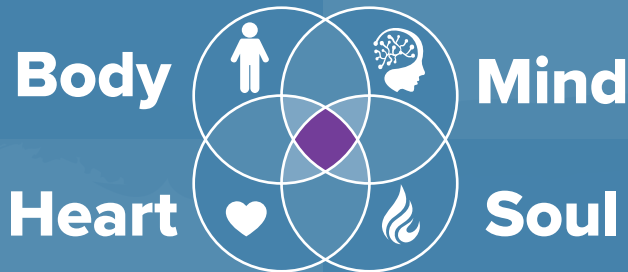

Knobelsdorff Puts Boots on the Ground for Hurricane Recovery

When hurricanes Milton and Helene devastated communities in Florida and the Carolinas, ABC members and chapters donated funds, equipment and their unique talents to rebuilding homes, businesses and lives. Peer Groups: A Top Member Benefit
