### Scope:

The Committee supports the ABC strategic goal to increase the political influence of ABC to advance the merit shop philosophy and free enterprise. It works within the federal election process to further the goals of the Association through educating members on the importance of political activism and through financial support of federal candidates. The Committee works with the Regional Vice Chairs and chapter leadership to promote political involvement and assist in raising ABC PAC funds as well as determining to whom those funds are allocated.
