Solid appointments so far





US Department Of Labor: A Closer Look

- Status of the White Collar OT rule injunction in effect appeals in abeyance waiting for new proposed rule (and a new WH Admin)
- Persuader rule same
- OSHA Injury Reporting in effect but changes expected (with a new OSHA Secy)
- Silica and Beryllium in effect but with phased enforcement and talks ongoing
- Apprenticeship opportunities on the horizon





Changes Coming To The NLRB

- Now a 3-2 Republican majority (temporarily)
- A solid new NLRB General Counsel is pushing to change course
- The Obama Board's radical Joint Employer standard under attack
- NLRB's war on employee handbooks may be scaled back soon
- Micro units and other new election rules could change for the better
- Pro-union Independent contractor standard
- Class arbitration issue pending at Supreme Court (where Justice Gorsuch could make the difference)





Unfinished Business

- The continuing fight over PLAs at the federal and state levels
- Davis-Bacon Reform
- Increasing recognition of ABC apprenticeship and craft training programs
- Health Care and Tax Reform
- Advancing the merit shop agenda at the state/local levels





ABC's Role In The Trump Administration

- Mike Bellaman appointed to the Apprenticeship Task Force
- Friends of ABC holding many key positions in the Administration
- Vital to stay engaged at all levels
- 2018 federal and state elections will be crucial
- Continuing battles at state and local levels
